Licensed Childcare Centers

Child Care New Mexico serves children ages 0 to 12 or 13, depending on the individual program, and is monitored by the Early Childhood Education and Care Department. Child Care providers are required to have background checks, building inspections, and basic training. Home-based child care providers have the option to become licensed or regulated by the state. A child care center must be licensed by the state with the exception of certain religious, tribal or parent-based organizations.

Child Find/SPED Preschool

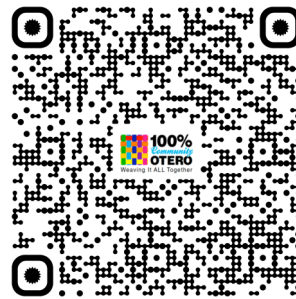
Child Find/SPED Preschool identifies and supports a child aged birth to 21 who are eligible for services that support developmental delays and disabilities. These services are typically provided in a public school setting, with learning or educational goals that are developed using an Individualized Education Plan. Free to qualifying families.

EI/FIT (Early Intervention/Family Infant Toddler)

NM Early Intervention services are provided to children up to age 3 who are eligible based on developmental delays or an established condition or disability and are typically provided in the child's natural environment. This program is free to qualifying families.

Licensed Family Childcare

Licensed Family Child Care is a residential setting that provides care for ages 0 to 12 years old, with one adult caring for multiple ages of children. Two Star quality and above accept Child Care Assistance.

Home Visiting

Provides home visiting services to pregnant mothers or primary care givers and their children, prenatal up to 3 or 5 years, depending on the program model. Home Visiting helps families gain knowledge regarding child development, connect with community support services, discover ways to support learning through play and interactions, receive emotional support through challenges associated with raising a child, and success support to get out of dangerous or unhealthy situations.

Head Start

Head Start and Early Head Start Centers are federally-funded non-residential settings, normally open during the school year only, and usually offering limited hours and sessions. Qualification requirements do exist for these programs. Early Head Start serves children 0 to 2 years old. Head Start serves children 3 to 5. These programs are free to qualifying families.

NM PreK

New Mexico PreK is a voluntary program funded by the state of New Mexico to ensure that every child in New Mexico, aged 4, or a three-year-old on an Individual Education Plan, has the opportunity to attend a high-quality early childhood education program before kindergarten. NM PreK begins at the start of the school year.
